

# LONELY HEART

Cabernet Sauvignon | Red Mountain | 2013



Every year our goal at Mark Ryan is to create a wine unlike any other offered in the Mark Ryan portfolio, and in the 2013 Lonely Heart we utilized Washington's finest site for Cabernet Sauvignon, Ciel du Cheval, to provide texture, nuance, and character. In addition, our custom plantings at Force Majeure provided purity, vitality and structure to our reserve blend. Throughout the year we had a sense that something special was happening, and as the year progressed from bud break, to set and through vérasion we saw the progress. The vines had produced naturally lower yields and very small berries hinting at the immense potential within each cluster. The warm 2013 Vintage allowed us to harvest all our Cabernet and Merlot in the month of September, between the 7th and 26th. Every effort is made to treat the wine as gently as possible; the product in never put through pumps and punching down the must caps gently twice per day. Fermentation rounds are performed twice daily, as to monitor fermentation and track when the wines are ready to be lightly pressed into barrel. The wine was aged in 79% new French oak for 21 months, and bottled on July 9th, 2015.
